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Silent Auction Rules

- 1. The auction is separate from the exhibition.
- 2. Members can offer birds for sale to sell excess personal stock and/or to raise money for the LCA.
- 3. All birds for auction will be judged.
- 4. Birds must be healthy and be presented in a clean and serviceable show cage with seed and water.
- 5. Only Classic (true bred) birds can be offered for sale any bird that is showing evidence that they may have originated from cross bred birds will not be accepted.
- 6. Any bird showing any of the recognised major faults will not be accepted.
- 7. Birds are to be sold singly and not in pairs. The cage is not included in the auction; potential bidders should bring their own transport cages.
- 8. Sales are limited to five birds per member.
- 9. A fee of £5.00 is payable for each bird entered for private sale in the silent auction payable via the entry form
- 10. No fee is charged for donated birds.
- 11. Bidding to start at £20 for every bird.
- 12. All bids will be deemed a commitment to buy; all bids to be in entire pounds (no pence); payments in cash only.
- 13. A sale/donation form is to be completed by the owner of the birds to be auctioned and sent to the show secretary along with the entry form and entry fee.
- 14. Labels for the sales birds will be issued by the show secretary. The record sheet for each seller will enable the birds to be booked in and provided to the auctioneer.
- 15. Bidders at the auction must be current paid-up members of the Association.
- 16. People may join the LCA on the morning of the sale if they wish to bid for birds.
- 17. Sales/donation birds will only be allowed in the hall once the show birds have been benched. Bidders will then be able to view the birds in advance of the auction.
- 18. No sales birds are to be removed from the hall until the necessary records have been updated, the appropriate payments have been made to the Auctioneer; the receipt is counter-signed by the Sales Steward and the bird is delivered by him/her to the buyer.

Timings

Sales entries benched from 9.15 a.m.

Sales birds judged at 10.00 a.m.

Bidding opens at 10.30 am.; bidding closes at 12.00 pm.; payments to be settled by 12.30 pm.

Sales birds will be offered to the second highest bidder if the top bid is not settled in time.
